The Fort King Heritage Association, Inc. is rebuilding historic Fort King on its original site at 3925 East Fort King Street.

This park, now open free-of-charge seven days a week, features a beautiful walking Interpretive Trail, the spring where the soldiers retrieved their water, picnic tables, and a Visitors Center complete with artifacts, displays, etc.

So what's missing? The Fort! The most significant fort of the Second Seminole War (1835-1842) and the historic birthplace of the City of Ocala.

Now we need your help! We need to sell 600 logs to reconstruct the 150' x 150' palisades of the fort and two blockhouses. In return, you receive a beautiful commemorative log with embossed logo, your name permanently engraved on a plaque inside the Visitors Center, and membership in the Fort King Heritage Association.
